### **October 2021:**

“Let me tell you my thoughts on the Ecco stove E678 , it wasn't a purchase that my wife and I bought without considerable investigation , not only because of the financial outlay, but also because of the claim that “it would heat every room in our house”, really we thought surely not, probably just a claim to sell more of them? Our aim was to reduce the amount of oil we were using, and do our little bit to become more environmentally friendly, So we had our heat plan calculated , got the results back , and to be fair to Ecco stove they even recommended a smaller model stove. We then went to our local supplier South West fireplaces and viewed the owners own Ecco Stove , liked the look of it and thought that's the model we want. We decided to go ahead and purchase the stove. Our cottage is built of flint it's over 200 years old, it is double glazed and has loft insulation ( minimal amount), and cannot be considered well insulated. The stove was fitted by South West Fireplaces and they also installed a chimney liner. At this point we were still in the have we done the right thing mode, but we needn't have worried , it's amazing how the stove gives off a really pleasant type of heat, and manages to keep the room it's in comfortably warm , while projecting heat around the house, you can stand in the doorways and feel the heat entering the rooms . There is no comparison to a standard wood burning stove, we had one of those and now looking back was a complete waste of money, the Ecco stove in my opinion is a home heating system. So any regrets ? No none whatsoever, the stove is a statement piece in the room, everyone that has seen the stove really admires it.
